Over his four decades of service with the company, he held senior positions in various functions including engineering, sales, product, marketing and wholesale business.

Peter graduated with a Higher Diploma in Electronic Engineering in 1982 from the Hong Kong Polytechnic (now Hong Kong Polytechnic University), and earned a Diploma in Management For Executive Development in 1991 from the Chinese University of Hong Kong. He was the chairman of the of the Joint Utilities Policy Group (JUPG) from 2012 to 2015. He is currently the President of Fixed Network & Value Added Services Group of the Communications Association of Hong Kong (CAHK) and a member of the Telecommunications Regulatory Affairs Advisory Committee (TRAAC).
