We were delighted to have overwhelming response with over 50 applications enrolled.



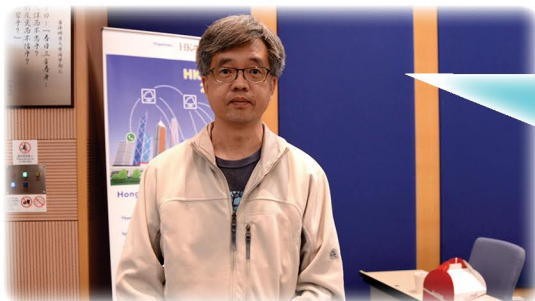
HKEPC2016 Champion of Industry Category -- Remotec Technology Limited project title: Smart AirCon IoT Product
